If they would say ‘I’m playing ...’ they use ‘jouer’. If they would say ‘I’m ...’ (eg. Children make a quick counter of a bicycle. Explain that this year in Summer, Paris will host the Olympics and new sports will be added. Introduce new vocabulary – children are not expected to learn this, it is to support their writing.</p> <p>Children are going to pretend they are an Olympic athlete and are being interviewed for a magazine. The interviewer is asking questions and they will write their answers using what they have learnt and the writing frame to support them.</p> <p>Present to the class when complete.</p>
