Overview

In this unit children learn to use e-mail to send and receive messages. They learn about communicating over distances and how to use email safely. They work together on a shared project using email.

- Emails may contain spoofed links links that look they are pointing to one website but are actually pointing to another
- Never click/tap a link in an email without checking
- Some emails may be spam (unwanted, unsolicited advertising)

- Keep your email address private
