Overview

In this unit children learn to use e-mail to send and receive messages. They learn about communicating over distances and how to use email safely. They work together on a shared project using email.

- * Don't open emails from anyone you don't know
- * If you receive an email that upsets you, tell a trusted adult
- * Always be polite when exchanging emails
- * Emails may contain viruses
- * Never click/tap on a link or open an attachment in an email without checking with an adult first
- * Emails may contain spoofed links – links that look they are pointing to one website but are actually pointing to another
- * Never click/tap a link in an email without checking
- * Some emails may be spam (unwanted, unsolicited advertising)
- * Some emails may be inappropriate
- * Keep your email address private
