If I make the right choice...

Level 5	<p>Headteacher Special Letter home</p> <p>Consistently high standard of behaviour and work; outstanding improvements to work/behaviour. Makes a significant contribution to school life.</p>
Level 4	<p>SLT Postcard home</p> <p>Outstanding behaviours and attitude is consistent. Dedicated and positive attitudes to work and the school ethos; supporting and caring towards others.</p>
Level 3	<p>Certificates</p> <p>Sustained good work and attitudes. Prepared for learning, on time to lessons. Sustained good behaviours at Level 2.</p>
Level 2	<p>Stickers – special mentions in class</p> <p>Polite, kind, helpful, arrives to school ready to learn, correct uniform, good role model of good behaviour to others.</p>
Level 1	<p>Merits and verbal praise</p> <p>Polite, helpful, general expectations of good behaviour: holding the door, walking sensibly.</p>



Sanctions Ladder



If I make the wrong choice...

Level 5	<p>Head Teacher or delegated authority Exclusion (linked to Exclusion Policy)</p> <p>Violent, abusive, consistent derogatory language, severe bullying, or serious incident, prohibited items, serious assault. In possession of prohibited items, may be a one off serious incident, or a series of behaviour breaches.</p>
Level 4	<p>Go to SLT Parents contacted, possible Fixed Term Exclusion/Loss of privileges</p> <p>Persistent use of bad language, Deliberately hurting another, derogatory language, poses a threat to another, theft. Any form of bullying, vandalism, fighting. Repeat of Level 3.</p>
Level 3	<p>Miss part or full break/behaviour club Parents informed and reported on CPOMs</p> <p>Bad language, persistent ignoring of instructions, poses a threat to another, threatening or angry behaviours, aggression. Poor attitude, non-completion of tasks.</p>
Level 2	<p>Name on the board/miss part or full break</p> <p>Not responding to a warning; repetition of Level 1 behaviours; ignoring instructions, unkind comments/shouting.</p>
Level 1	<p>Verbal warning</p> <p>Not following instruction, calling out, swinging on chair, incorrect uniform, being unkind.</p>
