

Year 6 Advent 2 Newsletter





In Science, our topic is Electricity. Children will be able to recognise different symbols of components in a series circuit. They will undertake science enquiries to measure how well a material or object conducts electricity. We will compare variations of components in electrical circuits and investigate how the voltage across the circuit affects the brightness of a lamp and the speed of a motor.



In Design and Technology,

children will be exploring healthy and unhealthy food. They will be comparing processed foods and looking at organic food. After studying a balanced diet, we will plan, cook and evaluate a meal that we have modified.

In History, we will be discussing the different causes of World War 2. Using primary and secondary sources to learn about the Battle of Britain and the impact it had on the war. We will go on to learn about the Blitz, rationing, shelters, roles of women and the legacy it left on the world



today. We will visit the International Bomber Command Centre to inspire us even more.
