
Year 5 Lent 1 Newsletter

In Geography, we will be discussing biomes. We will start by refreshing our memories on climate zones which we learnt about in Advent 1 and then move on to talk about the different biomes and how the conditions in these biomes affects the plants and animals that can survive there. In RE, we are starting our new topic, Mission.
