Our topic this half term is "Tell Me A Story"

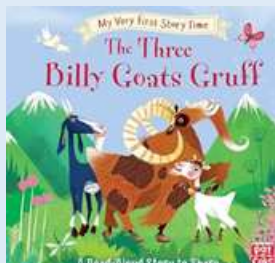
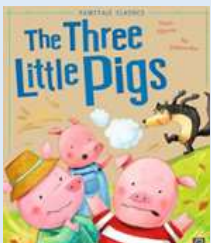
We will be learning about traditional tales and how to tell them using puppets and acting.

Literacy
