Our Stories This Term



Literacy

In literacy, we are concentrating on name writing and letter writing, helping children develop their foundational writing skills. We will also focus on retelling stories, using plays and actions to enhance their understanding and recall of narratives. Additionally, we will explore rhyming words, which will aid in their phonetic awareness and make learning language fun and engaging. Through these activities, children will improve their writing, storytelling, and language skills in an interactive and enjoyable way.

Maths

In maths, we are focusing on sequencing events, comparing different objects, and continuing our work on number recognition. Children will learn to order events logically, enhancing their understanding of time and sequence. They will also engage in activities that involve comparing various objects by size, weight, and other attributes, which will help develop their analytical skills.

Topic- Understanding the World

Our topic lessons each week are centred around a focus book. We will observe plant growth and changes in the weather. Through these books, children will discover new vocabulary and practice using it in their conversations and writing.
