Our **History** topic this term is **Roman Britain**. Children will be studying about Julius Caesar and Boudicca and learning the impact they had on British life. We will also be exploring how trade boosted the British economy.



In **Design and Technology**, the children are going to be designing and building a greenhouse within their **structure** topic. They will know that adding diagonal struts adds strength and stability and explore what materials will be the best choice to make a greenhouse.

In **RE** this term, we are continuing with how our decisions have consequences in our **Choices** topic. The next topic is **Special places** where learn all about pilgrimages and special places around the world that people visit. Our other faiths topic will be **Hinduism**.



In **Science** we are exploring **Light and Shadows**. Children will conduct experiments to see how a light source can create a shadow and will test different materials to see if they are reflective or non-reflective.
