We will be learning about occupations and how people in our community help us.

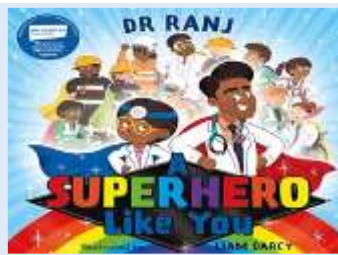
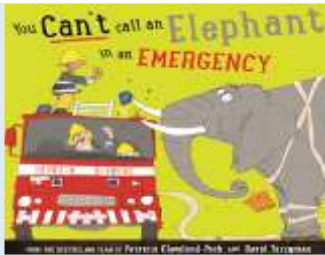

Our Stories This Term



Literacy

This term in nursery, we are focusing on building our early literacy skills by practicing our fisted grip. We're using this grip to draw shapes like circles and starting to explore letter formation. To make our grip even stronger, we're also doing "dough disco" exercises, which involve squeezing, pinching, and rolling dough. These activities help us prepare for writing by strengthening the muscles in our hands and fingers!

Maths

In maths, we are learning all about repeated patterns. We'll explore patterns we can find in songs and books, noticing how certain parts repeat. We'll also get creative by making our own repeated patterns using shapes, helping us to understand the concept of repetition and sequence.

Topic

In this topic, we will explore different occupations and learn how people in these roles support our community. Children will have the chance to meet professionals like firefighters, nurses, cooks, and others, allowing them to ask questions and gain insight into various job roles. There will also be plenty of opportunities for role play, which will help children build social skills, boost their confidence, and expand their vocabulary.

We will also learn about different celebrations around the world and perform a Christmas Nativity- the date for this has not yet been confirmed.
