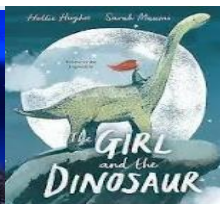
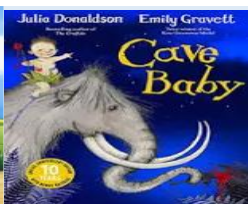
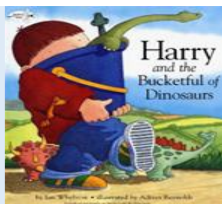

Our Stories This Term

We will bring the topic alive with a range of fiction and non-fiction books



Literacy- We will continue to learn to read and write a sound a day using the Read Write Inc. scheme we follow throughout the school. Children have been assessed and are now in different groups - they may bring home worksheets, blending books or Ditty sheets to complete at home. Each day we will complete letter formation activities to support the children to learn to write.

Maths- In maths this half term we will be learning to recognise numbers 0-5. We will be able to subitise and build numbers, finding them within our learning environment.

We will use language such as more and less to describe numbers.

We will then move onto our Mass and Capacity topic.

Topic - In the Dangerous Dinosaurs topic, your child will find out about prehistoric animals that live on Earth. They will learn facts about dinosaurs and discover how big some of these giant creatures were. They will learn about the difference between carnivores and herbivores.

They will also find out about the animals that lived after dinosaurs and which other modern-day animals also have prehistoric relatives.
