Our **History** focus this term is the Fishing Heritage of Grimsby. We will launch our topic with a trip to the Heritage Centre, following that we will discover what life was like as a 1950s fisherman, when Grimsby was the largest fishing port in the world. We will also explore what community life was like at that time and what changes happened during the Cod Wars. Children will make judgements on what they believe the legacy of the fishing industry is on our local town.

In **Design and Technology** children will design and construct a moving model of Corporation Bridge. This project will teach them three types of mechanisms: sliders, levers and linkages.



In **Maths** we will be finishing our unit on **Multiplication and Division** then moving on to **Measurement**, starting with **Length** and height followed by **Mass, capacity** and **temperature**. In **English** our writing focus this term will be a **traditional tale narrative**. **Reading books and records** to be sent in everyday please. **Raffle Tickets** are awarded for 3 recorded 10 minute reads at home.
