Our Geography topic this half term is Volcanoes and Earthquakes. We will learn about what Causes these natural disasters and how they affect the local area.

The children will discover where volcanoes are usually found and explore the different types of volcanoes.

In RE this term we begin with exploring the the JOURNEY that a Christian participates in over the liturgical year. Next, the children will understand the importance of being part of a Catholic community in our LISTENING & SHARING topic.



In Art the main focus will be painting. The Children are going to be exploring the work of Leonid Afremov and his impressionism art style. They will learn about different strokes and how colour and light affect the mood of a painting.
