In Geography, we will be discussing the economical activity in Grimsby. Using a range of sources, we will learn about the trade links from Grimsby to the UK, Europe and the wider world. We will discuss how non-renewable energy has an impact on the local area and the renewable energy

contributions that are already in place. Finally, we will look at the regeneration plans for Grimsby, to make a vibrant successful town.
