In Science, our topic is **Living things and their habitats**. Children will be able to identify that most living things live in habitats to which they are suited and describe how different habitats provide for the basic needs of different kinds of animals and plants. Children will experience first-hand how a wormery functions and how to build a bug hotel.



In Design and Technology children will be exploring nutrition and working towards designing and cooking an Asian meal. They will learn where food comes from, the best tools to use to perform different tasks and designing a tasty and nutritious meal.



In Maths we will continue with our **Addition and Subtraction** unit before moving onto **Shape**. In English our writing focus this term will be a **descriptive character narrative** based on our class story *The Fantastic Mr Fox*. Our reading skills book this term will be *Flat Stanley*.
