

Our **Geography** topic this term is about our local area **Grimsby**, and beyond. We will discover what the physical and human features are and how the land is used. Children will interpret a range of sources of geographical information and use simple fieldwork and observational skills to identify similarities and differences with the nearby city of Hull, and further afield with Barcelona.

In **RE** this term we begin our Galilee to Jerusalem branch exploring how we can live more like Jesus, how we can help build the Kingdom and what we learn about our relationship with God from Jesus' journey from Galilee to Jerusalem.



In **Art**, we will be exploring the famous work of Tanzanian painter Edward Tingatinga. His work was renowned for depicting stereotypical African icons using bright and vivid colours



In **Science** we are investigating **Humans, including animals**. Children will notice that animals, including humans, have offspring which grow into adults. They will find out about and describe the basic needs of animals, including humans, for survival (water, food and air) and describe the importance for humans of exercise, eating the right amounts of different types of food, and hygiene.



In **Maths** we will be beginning our unit on **Money** followed by **Multiplication and Division**. In **English** our writing focus this term will be a **recount** in the style of a letter followed by a **non-chronological information text**.
