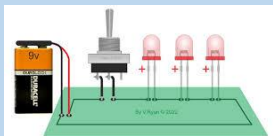


Year 6 Advent 2 Newsletter



PE Wednesday and Thursday

In **Science**, our topic is **Electricity**. Children will be able to recognise different symbols of components in a series circuit. They will undertake science enquiries to measure how well a material or object conducts electricity. We will compare variations of components in electrical circuits and investigate how the voltage across the circuit affects the brightness of a lamp and the speed of a motor.



In **Design and Technology**, children will be exploring healthy and unhealthy food. They will be comparing processed foods and looking at organic food. After studying a balanced diet, we will plan, cook and evaluate a meal that we have modified.

In **History**, we will be discussing the different causes of **World War 2**. Using primary and secondary sources to learn about the Battle of Britain and the impact it had on the war. We will go on to learn about the Blitz, rationing, shelters, roles of women and the legacy it left on the world



today. We will have a visitor from the National Archives to enrich our experiences of what life was like.

In **RE**, we will be looking at prophecy and promise. We will reflect on our own experience, consider the women in our lives who have been important or significant. Comparing our own and others' experiences about the importance of Mary the mother of Jesus in spiritual life. We will consider what life or task God might be calling us to live or do and reflect on how our 'Yes' could transform our own lives and the lives of the community.

In **Maths**, we will continue with long division in our **four calculations** unit before moving onto **fractions**. In **English**, our writing focus this term will be a **fact file** and a **descriptive character narrative**. Our reading skills book this term will continue to be **Letters from the Lighthouse**. Reading books and records to be sent in everyday please. Dojos awarded for 3 recorded 10 minute reads at home.
