In **Science**, our topic is **Circulatory system**. Children will be able to understand the system that moves blood around the body. They will undertake science investigations while dissecting the heart and recognise its different parts. As we make blood, we will recognise the components and understand their properties. We will look at the three main blood vessels within the human body.



In **Geography**, we will be discussing the **economic activity** in Grimsby. Using a range of sources, we will learn about the **trade links** from Grimsby to the UK, Europe and the wider world. We will discuss how **non-renewable energy** has an impact on the local area and the **renewable energy** contributions that are already in place. Finally, we will look at the regeneration plans for Grimsby, to make a vibrant successful town.



In **Art**, children will be studying **Vincent Van Gogh** and how he used **expressionism** in his paintings. We will begin by exploring harmonious colours to create emotions and moods. We will create '**Starry Night**' by using different textures, techniques and patterns.



In **RE**, we are moving on to our new topic, Galilee to Jerusalem. To know the seven sacraments of the Catholic faith. To explain the purpose of each sacrament in the life of the Catholic Church. To know the purpose of sacraments is to help people grow more like Jesus, and through Him become more like Jesus, and through Him become more like children of God. The children continue to confidently show how their own and others' decisions are informed by beliefs and values.

In **Maths**, we will begin the term converting metric and imperial measurements before moving on to understanding ratio, algebra and decimals.

In **English**, our writing focus this term will be a **newspaper article** and an **explanation**.

Our reading skills book this term will be **Secrets of the Sun King** by Emma Carroll.
