Our **History** focus this term is the Fishing Heritage of Grimsby. We will launch our topic with a trip to the Heritage centre, following that we will discover what life was like as a 1950s fisherman, when Grimsby was the largest fishing port in the world. We will also explore what community life was like at that time and what changes happened during the Cod Wars. Children will make judgements on what they believe the legacy of the fishing industry is on our local town.

In **RE** this term our topic is **Desert to Garden**. Children will recognise Lent is a time for reconciliation and forgiveness. They will also understand the symbols of light and water in the Easter Vigil Mass.



In **PE** our unit is **OAA** (outdoor adventurous activities). Children will be using their problem solving skills alongside their physical knowledge to complete teamwork activities.



In **Design and Technology** children will design and construct a moving model of Corporation Bridge. This project will teach them three types of mechanisms: sliders, levers and linkages.



In **Science** we are continuing with our **Animals including humans** unit. We will identify what humans need to survive as well as understanding that a healthy diet, exercise and good hygiene help us to lead a healthy lifestyle.



In **Maths** we will be finishing our unit on **Multiplication and Division** then moving on to **Measurement**, starting with **Length** and height followed by **Mass, capacity and temperature**. In **English** our writing focus this term will be a **traditional tale narrative**. **Reading books and records** to be sent in everyday please. **Raffle Tickets** are awarded for 3 recorded 10 minute reads at home.
