Our **Geography** topic this term is **Canada**, where children will study this non-European country. The children will learn where Canada is on the map and explore Canadian forests and the tundra. We will learn all about how Canada exports their natural resources and understand how this trade effects their economy. We will also investigate how climate change is impacting the different regions of Canada.



In **RE** this term we begin with exploring our new topic to the ends of the **Earth**. In this topic we will be listening to the scripture 'The road to Emmaus' and seeing how links to the different parts of mass. We will also be looking at the different parts of the Holy Trinity and creating our own artwork on this.

In **Art**, the children are going to be studying structures and the artist Juan Muñoz. We will specifically focus on figure sculptures and how these can tell a story through action and movement. The children will also be exploring the medium papier-mâché and how this uses a structure to make the sculpture.



In **Science** we are investigating **plant nutrition and reproduction**. The children will learn all about the different parts of the plant and their function. We will also investigate parts of a flower and how pollination and seed dispersal is part of plant reproduction.

In **Maths** we will be starting our **Mass and capacity** topic and then starting our second **fractions** topic to deepen our understanding of fractions in relation to amounts.

In **English** our writing focus this term will be a **folk tale** from Canada.
