In **Science**, we will be focusing on our topic around evolution and inheritance. Children will be able to recognise how life on Earth has evolved from simple life forms. We will develop our conceptual understanding of natural selection and artificial selection, and the positive effects they have on subsequent generations. We will further our studies by researching how adaptations evolve by natural selection for all living things: plants and animals.



In **Geography**, we will be focusing on Mexico. The children will study a non-European area in comparison to Grimsby, Hull and Germany. Research will help us to identify the characteristics and traditions of Mexico and how they compare to ours. We will link previous learning of biomes, climate change and geographical information to our studies and discover how their trade supports the community of Mexico.



In **Art**, children will be exploring the artist

Alberto Giacometti.

We will study his sculptures and create our own.



In **RE**, we will begin our next branch, 'To the Ends of the Earth'.

The children will gain an understanding of Christian belief in the Resurrection of Christ and the revelation of the Father, Son and Spirit. The children will know different ways in which Christians bear witness to their beliefs now and in the past and make links with the life of a saint.



In **Maths**, we will begin our unit on ration, which will then lead us into algebra and how to form expressions. We will complete our unit on statistics before our tests in May.

In **English**, we will be focusing on punctuation, grammar and spellings to prepare for SATS. Our reading skills book this term will continue to be 'Secrets of the Sun King'.
