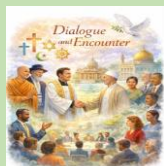
Our **History** topic this term is **Kings and Queens**. Children will be studying three of the most significant monarchs of British History and learning the impact they had on British life. By using historical enquiry skills, they will decide which monarch they believe was the most significant.



In **Design and Technology**, children will learn about textiles and how to sew, understanding what a running stitch is. They will apply this new knowledge and skill to follow a pattern for an African inspired bag tag.



In **RE** we move onto our final branch, **Dialogue and Encounter**. In this branch, pupils will learn how Christians work together with people of different religious convictions and all people of goodwill towards the common good, respecting the dignity of all humanity. They will also encounter other pathways of belief drawing on the teaching of the Church about intercultural dialogue.



In **Science** we are exploring **Everyday Materials**. Children will explore the different types of materials we use for different purposes and understand why their properties are key to them being used.



In **Maths** we will begin our unit on **Time** and end the the year looking at **Statistics** and **Position and Direction**. Please continue to use TTRockstars for multiplication and division practice at home.

In **English** our writing focus this term will be a **persuasive** text in the form of an advert and we will be learning some performance poetry.
