Our **History** topic this term is **Ancient Greece**. Children will be learning about the legacy that Ancient Greece has left on our world today. This includes their influence on the English language, democracy, sport and the Olympics, maths, science, philosophy, art, architecture and theatre.



In **Design and Technology**, the children are going to be designing and building a functional building. We will recap what makes a strong structure and explore how to create greater stability in structures. We will also look at how computer-aided designs can help with the design process.

In **RE** this term, we will be starting our Branch 6, the final branch of the year, which is called **Dialogue and Encounter**. This discusses how the Christian faith links into the Jewish faith and the different parts of the Bible.



In **Science** we are continuing our topic of **Properties and Changes of Materials**. Children will conduct experiments to explore how materials are changed by certain different methods and whether these changes are reversible or not.



In **Maths**, we will be completing our **decimals** topic and then move onto **negative numbers** and **measurement**.

In **English**, our writing focus this term will be a **persuasive letter**, **discussion text** and **performance poetry**.
